

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

The Gray County Indigent Health Care Program follows rules and procedures established under the Texas Indigent Health Care and Treatment Act to comply with its responsibility of assisting eligible residents of Gray County who are in need of Basic Health Care Assistance.

Residents who meet the eligibility criteria may receive assistance for the following: Hospital Inpatient/Outpatient Services, Ambulatory Surgical Center Services, Physician Services, Lab/X-ray Services, and Prescription Services.

Eligibility for the program is determined by reviewing residency, household composition, income, and resources. Applicants with countable income in excess of 21% of the Federal Poverty Guideline do not qualify nor do those with countable resources in excess of \$2,000.00 (\$3,000.00 when a person who lives in the home is aged or disabled and meets relationship requirements).

- Applicants must fill out an application and participate in an interview.
- Applicants must provide all information and documentation requested to verify income, residency, household composition, and resources, or application will be denied.
- Applicants and household members must pursue all available income/resources to which they are legally entitled and comply with department referrals to register or apply for other programs such as Medicaid, child support, SSA benefits, SNAP, TANF, unemployment, Texas Workforce, Victims of Crime, etc.
- Any changes that may affect eligibility must be reported within 14 days to prevent financial penalties.

CAUTION: Individuals who present false information in order to wrongfully secure medical benefits will be subject to criminal and civil charges.

Applicants have the right to appeal adverse decisions. The County of Gray strictly adheres to equal treatment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, political belief, or handicap.
